

Dear Licensee

As per the enclosed communications, LPOG propose to shortly commence the process of applying to the Australian Competition and Consumer Commission (**ACCC**) for authorization to collectively bargain with Australia Post in relation to the terms and conditions of current and/or future Licensed Post Office Agreements (**LPO Agreement**) of full financial members of LPOG.

A collective bargaining authorization from the ACCC would enable LPO Group (**LPOG**), and its financial members only, to approach Australia Post and seek to collectively negotiate more equitable terms and conditions into the LPO Agreement (or a new agreement) between Australia Post and those licensees that opt to be included as part of the collective bargaining arrangement.

If you are a full financial member, and content for LPOG to act on your behalf to seek authorization from the ACCC to collectively bargain with Australia Post in relation to the LPO Agreement, please sign the consent form below, and return to LPOG at your earliest convenience.
