In consideration of the fact that many Licensees are financially stressed, or their LPOs are a minor portion of the in conjunction business, LPOG is offering a limited 2016 membership (no member access to the LPOG website) to end on 30-06-2017, for the exclusive right to be named in the ACCC application process only, as an LPOG member.
